

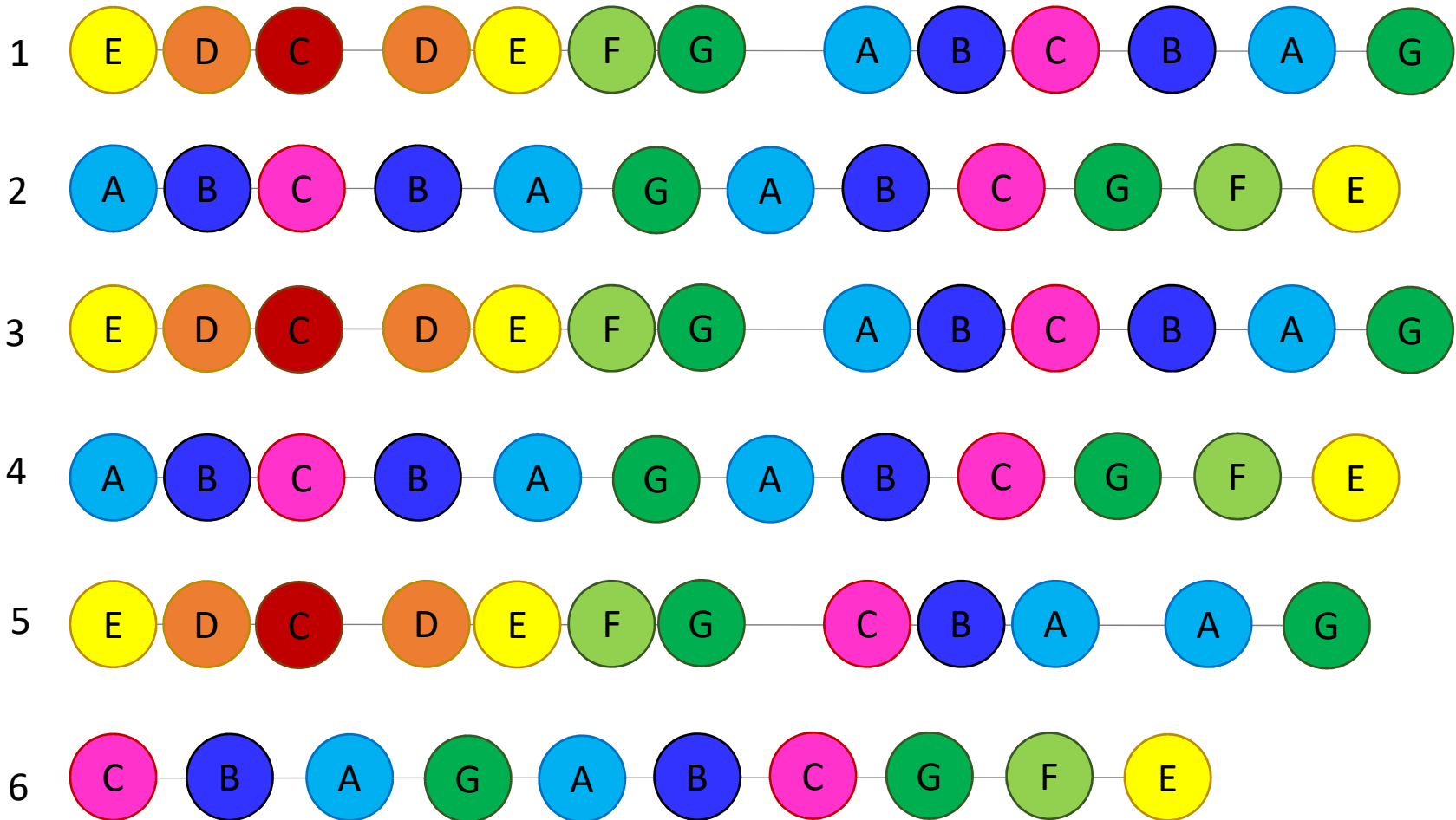

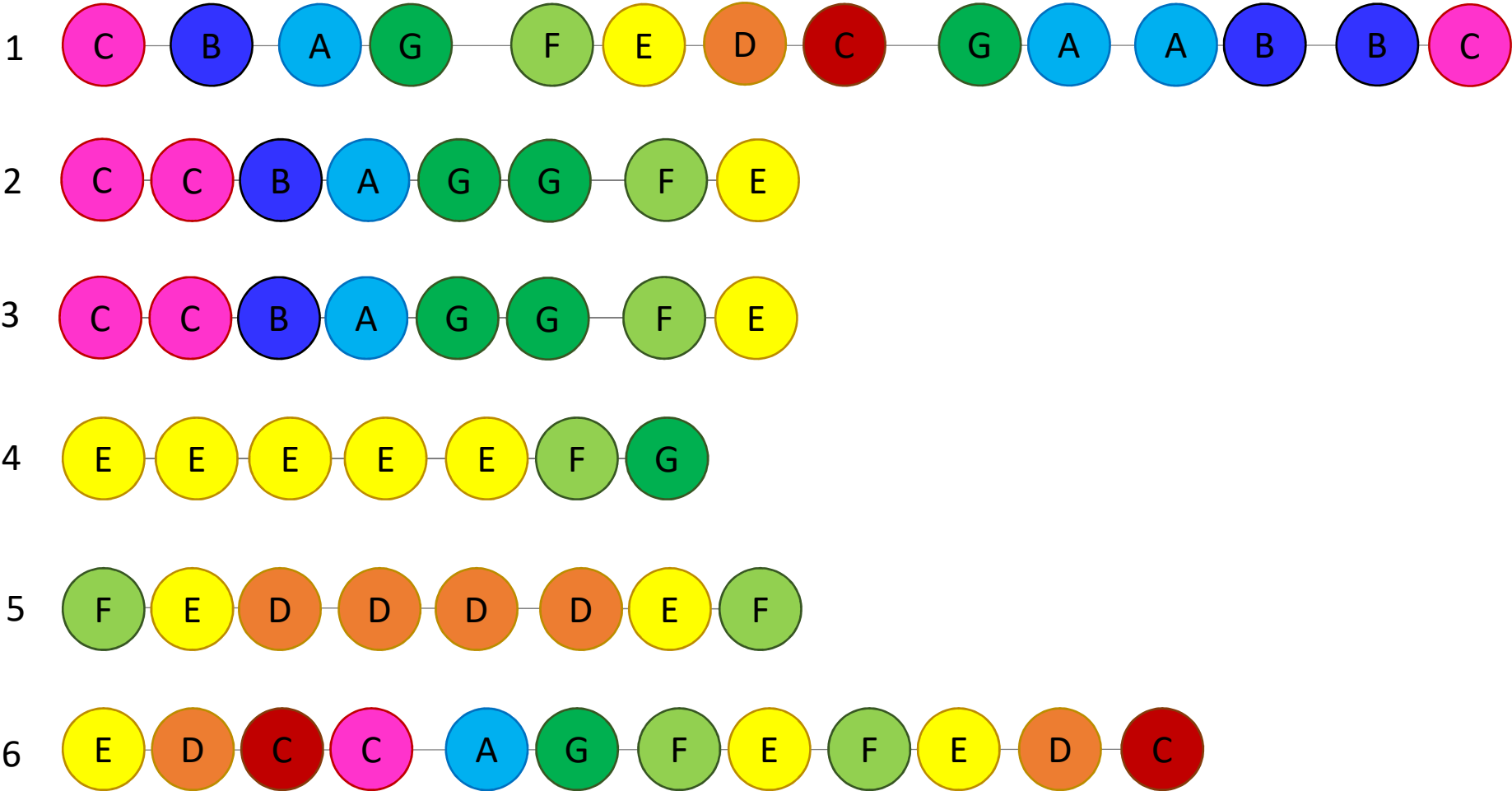
THE FIRST NOEL
